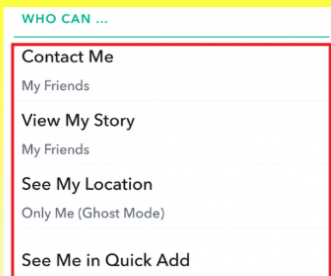
Snapchat Safety

Be safe - Snap safe.



Make sure to edit these privacy settings in Snapchat so that you can always be safe while sharing pictures!

Remember, never add anyone you don't know on Snapchat. Never send photos you wouldn't be comfortable sharing with your parents.



- When taking a photo, pinch your screen to open Snap Map.
- Tap the settings icon (in top right corner).
- Select Ghost Mode to turn off location sharing.



1. Do not give out personal information such as your address, telephone number, the name of your school, etc.
2. Use a screen name instead of your real name.
3. Do not post pictures of yourself, or your friends without their permission, on public sites.
4. Check with your parents before using any social media apps.
5. Tell your parents right away if you see something that upsets you.
6. Do not reply to any messages that are mean. Screenshot the message and tell your parents right away.
7. Do not use swear words or threats in your messages.
8. Do not make online friends. Only send messages or video chat with people you know in real life.
9. Do not open e-mail attachments from strangers.
10. Do not tell anyone your passwords.
11. Do not send nudes to anyone. If someone sends a nude to you tell an adult straight away. If you are under the age of 18 it is illegal and you could be arrested.
12. Check a website is secure before you download anything, like music or a movie.
