



## School Improvement Plan 2021 2022– Parent version

The 2021 – 2022 academic year has started against a backdrop of the COVID19 pandemic and 18 months of significant disruption. For the second year in a row public examinations were cancelled, and schools went through periods of pandemic related closure, disrupting access to in person education for children across the country. Despite the disruption they faced, our 2021 Year 11 leavers performed well in their GCSE, BTEC and Functional Skills qualifications in a wide range subjects relative to their start points.
