Limpsfield Grange School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff, Governors, visitors, contractors and volunteers to share this commitment. We recognise our moral and statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of all children.

We make every effort to provide an environment in which children and adults feel safe, secure, valued and respected, and feel confident to talk if they are worried, believing they will be effectively listened to.

This means that we have a Child Protection & Safeguarding Policy and procedures in place which is available on our website. The purpose of this policy is to provide staff, Governors, visitors, contractors and volunteers with the framework they need in order to keep children safe and secure in our school. The policy also informs parents and carers how we will safeguard their children whilst they are in our care.

All staff, Governors, visitors, contractors and volunteers must ensure that they are aware of these procedures. Parents, carers and students are welcome to read the Child Protection & Safeguarding policy which is available on our website.

Sometimes we may need to share information and work in partnership with other agencies when there are concerns about a student’s welfare.

If your concerns relate to the actions or behaviour of a member of staff (which could suggest that they are a danger to children), then you should report this in confidence to the Headteacher – head@limpsfield-grange.surrey.sch.uk (or the Chair of Governors mrs.tanner@limpsfield-grange.surrey.sch.uk if the concern relates to the Headteacher) who will take appropriate action.
